Duck, NC – Situated on a narrow strip of land that is part of one of the few remaining natural barrier island chains in the world, Sanderling Resort offers guests unpretentious elegance and unforgettable experiences to be found only on the Outer Banks. From wild Spanish Mustangs that roam Currituck Beach, exotic birds taking flights of fancy in the Audubon Sanctuary and tales of swashbuckling pirates and maritime mysteries, the Outer Banks delicately balances the past and present on its pristine shores.

Sanderling Resort is perfectly positioned in the town of Duck, just minutes from sacred spots that have played an integral part in our nation's history. The birthplace of flight, Kitty Hawk, boasts the Wright Brothers Memorial and Roanoke, the famous lost colony of first English settlers who mysteriously disappeared from its banks, are both nearby. Real-life pirate legends come to life on the beaches of the Outer Banks, known as the "Graveyard of the Atlantic" where more than 2,000 ships have made watery graves along North Carolina's shores. History may even be found right in the walls of the resort, where Lifesaving Station, once part of a coastal chain of lookouts, now serves as a restaurant, welcoming guests into rooms steeped with stories of the sea.

The resort is also both a protector and steward of the delicate ecology of the Outer Banks, which can be found right outside its doors. In addition to housing a rare reproduction of a book illustrated by famous environmentalist James Audubon, the resort resides next to a 3,400 acre sanctuary called Pine Island Audubon Sanctuary. A favorite resting spot of double-breasted cormorants, northern harrier and sharp-shinned hawks, Virginia rails and black-bellied plover; the sanctuary is a bird-watchers paradise. Other encounters with nature are not far away at the Pea Island Wildlife Refuge and the Nags Head Woods, a protected maritime forest home to miles of hiking trails. Perhaps the most recognizable symbol of the Outer Banks, wild Spanish mustangs, can be found roaming the beaches of Corolla, easily viewed in an open-air JEEP excursion the Sanderling offers. For guests who just can't get enough of the outdoors, Kitty Hawk Kites, the largest water based outfitter on the Outer Banks, offers on-property activities including kayaking, surfing, paddle-boarding, skim-boarding and bicycle rentals.

A destination for all generations, Sanderling Resort offers southern charm with a modern sensibility. It's the perfect place for families and couples to reconnect and be swept away by the natural beauty of their surroundings.
